

Below is a list of items to complete in preparation for May 2017 degree conferral and the May

2017 graduation ceremony.

*Please note that this list will not appear sequentially for all students nor is it a complete list of things that need to be done; your department or the office of the registrar might require other items to prepare for graduation. Please keep in touch with your department coordinator for all activities surrounding graduation.

- AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SEMESTER: Let your department coordinator know that you plan to graduate this semester. Verify that all necessary degree requirements have been or will be met.
- Work with your graduate coordinator to verify that you have petitioned for candidacy before February 24, 2017. Petitions are available at http://graduate.rice.edu/forms.
 - o Please note, this petition may have been completed at an earlier date.
- Submit an <u>Application for Degree</u> (available in <u>Esther</u>) to the Registrar's Office by February 24, 2017.
- Order Regalia! Regalia should be ordered from the Campus Bookstore by the end of March for best selection. For more information, visit graduate.rice.edu/regalia or call 713-348-4052.
- Register for the hooding ceremony and RSVP for the doctoral luncheon. Check your Rice email
 for information. If you do not receive an email regarding these events by March 24, please
 contact graduate@rice.edu.
- Submit an Announcement of Thesis Defense to Rice Events Calendar at least 2 weeks (14 calendar days) before defense date via http://events.rice.edu/rgs/.
- Successfully defend thesis **and** submit to the Office of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies online thesis submission site the signed approval of candidacy form and defended draft of the thesis.
- Submit final thesis to Office of Graduate Studies by Noon, Friday, April 21st!

 - Normal thesis submission hours are Monday Friday, 1:30 3:30 p.m., but from April 10 20th, hours will be 8:30 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 4:00 p.m. On April 21st, theses can be submitted from 8:30 a.m. to noon only.
