

## **Master's Graduation Checklist**

Below is a list of items to complete in preparation for May 2017 degree conferral and May 2017 graduation.

\*Please note that this list will not appear sequentially for all students nor is it a complete list of things that need to be done; your department or the office of the registrar might require other items to prepare for graduation. Please keep in touch with your department coordinator for all activities surrounding graduation.

- NON-THESIS MASTER'S and CANDIDACY (AUTOMATIC) MASTER'S ONLY: Work with your graduate coordinator to submit a petition for Master's degree to Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies before February 24, 2017. Petitions are available at graduate.rice.edu/forms.
- ALL DEGREE CANDIDATES: Submit an Application for Degree (available in Esther) to the Registrar's Office by February 24, 2017.
- Order Regalia! Regalia should be ordered from the Campus Bookstore by the end of March for best selection. For more information, visit graduate.rice.edu/regalia or call **713-348-4052**.
- THESIS MASTER'S ONLY: Send in an Announcement of Thesis Defense to Rice Events Calendar at least 1 week (seven calendar days) before defense date to http://events.rice.edu/rgs/.
- THESIS MASTER'S ONLY: Successfully defend thesis and submit the signed approval of candidacy
  form to the Office of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies online thesis submission site. Please
  indicate on this form if you plan to register in the semester following your defense (Fall 2016).
- THESIS MASTER'S ONLY: Submit final thesis documents to Office of Graduate Studies by Noon,
   Friday, April 21<sup>st</sup>!

  - Normal thesis submission hours are Monday Friday, 1:30 3:30 p.m., but from April 10 20<sup>th</sup>, hours will be 8:30 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 4:00 p.m. On April 21<sup>st</sup> theses can be submitted from 8:30 a.m. to noon only.
- The 2017 **Masters' Convocation** will take place on Friday, May 12, 2016, from 9:00-10:30 A.M. in the Stude Concert Hall at the Shepherd School of Music's Alice Pratt Brown Hall.

- PARTICIPATE IN COMMENCEMENT! May 13th, 7:00 am line up for Commencement. All degree candidates (even those continuing) may participate in commencement exercises.
